



2024 Blackfoot Ranch Rodeo and Indian Relays Races

***** WSRRA Open and Womens SANCTIONED Event*****

Contestant check in for all events will be at the “Contestant Info Tent” located by the announcer’s box. All contestants must check in and have a signed liability waiver on file before competing.

Ranch Rodeo: 4-person Open/Women’s Team, \$180/contestant. Total of 20 teams max (6 spots held for the women’s teams). **Team Events:** Team branding, Team Roping (all 4 rope), Team mugging, Trailer loading,

Open - Payout in each event – no overall team payout. Trophy bits to the winning team based on placing in all 4 team events. Prizes for 2nd - 4th place.

Women’s - Single payout based on highest point team in all four events and buckles for the winning team. Payout to 1st and 2nd.

Trailer Loading, Team Mugging, Bedroll Race, Wild Cow Race, Bronc riding, and Team Roping will take place during Friday or Saturday night performances. Team Branding for ranch rodeo will be part of the open branding on Saturday morning. Teams can sign-up to compete in either the Friday night or Saturday night performance. Contestants can enter more than once in a night performance as long as teams aren’t so interrelated that we can’t run some events in two or three heats. 2 entry limit, change out 1 team member. **Entries open May 15th and close June 15th**. Limited to 10 teams in each evening performance.

Horse show: Friday following the horsemanship clinic. Open, Novice, and Youth (16 and under) classes. Not required to be on a ranch rodeo team to participate. **Top Horse award:** Trophy Brooks Brothers Silver Bit will be presented to high point earning horse in Rodear roping, Fence work, and Ranch Reining. Dave Severe Romel Reins for reserve top horse. Payout in all three classes and buckles for top of each class. See rules for details

- **Horsemanship Clinic** - Clinic to start Friday morning 8:00- 10:00 a.m. limited to 10 horseback entries \$60, free to audit.
- **Rodear Roping-** Friday at 11:00 a.m. \$45 open /\$45 novice /\$25 youth plus \$30 cattle fee, limited to 1 horse unless cross entered in Fence work and Ranch Reining, then limited to 2 horses
- **Fence work-** Friday following rodear roping. \$45 open /\$45 novice /\$25 youth plus \$30 cattle fee, limit

2 horses

- **Ranch Reining-** Friday at 10:30 am. Ran concurrent with Rodear roping in the infield \$45 open /\$45 novice /\$25 youth, limit 2 horses.

Other contests: events that don't require a ranch rodeo team to enter

- **Ranch Bronc Riding - WSRRA Sanctioned 40 Points 8 Second Whiskey Tour Stop** . Long go each night. Top 4 highest scores between both performances returning Saturday Night for short go. Payout based on winner of short go (no average). \$125 entry fee. Limited to 16 entries, 8 head in each performance, will accept second entries after June 10th. Buckle for first and cash payout with added money for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th. Entry fee due by June 15th.
- **Rafter K Bedroll Race** - \$20 per team, limited to 6 teams each night. Friday night is a junior division where the rider must be 16 and under. Saturday night is an open division. Buckles for winning team.
- **Wild Cow Race** – Youth will dress up and ride a saddled steer in a race across the arena for a buckle. \$20 entry fee. 14 and under. Costumes required
- **Open Team Branding** - Sign up at the **free breakfast** at 8:00 a.m. Ranch Rodeo teams will rope first starting at 8:00 am everyone else will start roping at 9:00, Enter 3 times in the open (including ranch rodeo entries) 2 in the mixed and 2 times in novice. Please have all entries placed by 9:00 am. **Open and Mixed Branding will be a State Fair Qualifier!** Open: \$45/Man. Mixed: \$30/Man (two ropers must be 16 and under or women) Novice: \$25/man (two ropers must be youth or novice ropers)
- **Mutton Bustin** - part of the pre show at 5:30, riders must be under 55 lbs and under 7 years old. Riders must bring their own helmet and vest. Entries are \$35 (includes a t-shirt). Buckle for Champion Mutton Buster. Weigh-in starts at 5 pm.
- **Pretty n' Punchy Contest** - Blackfoot's Ranch Rodeo's queen contest, but with a ranch style spin. For girls ages 11-21. Girls will be judged on horsemanship skills and modeling. Contest will be Thursday June 27th @ 9:00 AM. Entries are due June 1st. Buckles awarded to top cowgirls during Friday night Pre-Show. Call Nicole for more details.
